As per the by-law 10.1 (b) (i) that animal is at all times under the control of the owner or occupier, meaning on leash, of the lot in which the animal is kept or permitted to be in or by another responsible person over the age of 13 years of age; and (ii) the owner or occupier of the lot in which the animal is kept or permitted to be in shall be responsible for ensuring that the Common Property is kept in a clean and tidy condition and that no damage is caused to the Common Property by the animal.

For our cat owners the by-law applies to you too including picking up after your cat. Many residents have been complaining of cats roaming the estate, both day and night. **Rules for Motorised Personal Mobility Devices**

In Queensland, a personal mobility device can be used on road-related areas such as paths and nature strips.

Children under 12 must not use a personal mobility device.

When you're using one, **you must:**

- be supervised by an adult if you're 12-15
- wear an approved bicycle helmet that is securely fitted
- give way to pedestrians on paths
- keep left of oncoming bicycles and other personal mobility devices on paths
- have a working warning device, such as a bell or horn
- have a working flashing or steady white light on the front, and a red light and reflector at the rear when travelling at night or in hazardous conditions.

You are allowed to stay on your personal mobility device to cross a road at a designated crossing.

When you're operating a personal mobility device, **you must not:**

- travel faster than 12km/h
- travel along a road unless it's impractical not to, or if there's an obstruction on the path or nature strip—in these cases you're allowed to travel up to 50m on the road
- carry any passengers
- use a hand-held mobile phone
- drink or be under the influence of alcohol

## Father's Day Origins:
